Additionally, he is a strong aged bull that offers progressive terminal traits, his daughters will be bred to excel in milk production and his own CED/BW EPDs indicate he is suitable to utilize as low calving difficulty sire. We believe this junior herd sire to be well suited for advancing a set of cows whether it be for making replacement females or a set of calves for a terminal market.

Lot 33 footnote: "Rampage J70" offers a pedigree stacked with prominent AI sires and a \$B index ranking in the top 20% of the breed. His pedigree and growth figures tell us that he will sire an impressive set of calves at weaning who continue to sort themselves to the top as they progress into maturity. This age advantaged bull is tailor made for coving big groups of cows and is sure to be the front pasture.
